Our figures to date highlight that since its inception 3 years ago, Cupar Foodbank has fed more than 4000 people providing 48,000 plus meals. The past few weeks have seen us getting busier and we are currently giving out approx 280kg of food per week. However the amount of food being donated is amounting to approx 100kg per week. As such our stocks are getting very low on certain items. We would be most grateful if you can help in any way you can. Thank you. Items we are extremely short of are as follows:
